The Population Council Deploys Global Protection with Kaspersky Lab

In the Fall of 2008 The Population Council faced a technical problem.

“The anti-virus software we were using in the United States began failing in our international offices,” says Stan Mierzwa, Director of IT for the Council. “Malware and viruses were getting through our anti-virus software, causing performance problems and taking our focus away from our core mission.”

That core mission is to improve the well-being and reproductive health of current and future generations around the world and to help achieve a humane, equitable, and sustainable balance between people and resources. A nonprofit, non-governmental organization, the Council conducts research in three areas: HIV and AIDS; poverty, gender, and youth; and reproductive health.

With over 520 employees in 21 offices around the world, The Population Council is truly a global organization. “We rely on our international offices to carry out the organization’s many projects, so it was important that we ask them to do the analysis on which platform to use worldwide,” Stan recalls. “It was the international offices that suggested that the corporate office look into Kaspersky Lab.” The research and analysis was performed by Adan Isaac in Kenya, Ashutosh Mishra in India, Ahmed Kodira in Egypt, and Khalil Mohammad in Pakistan.

“They told us that Kaspersky works!” reports Mike Lim, Senior Systems Engineer for The Population Council. “And since we were already looking for a security application that we could standardize for global centralization, we decided to give Kaspersky Work Space Security a try.
